PRO BONO REPRESENTATION

The majority of parties in matters before the Intertribal Court of Southern California are unrepresented.

Although representation is likely to improve outcomes for any party, it is particularly impactful in matters involving the health, safety, and welfare of tribal children, families, and vulnerable adults.

Attorneys appearing before the Intertribal Court of Southern California, as members of the Southern California Tribal Bar Association, may elect to have their contact information and practice area(s) shared with parties in need of pro bono services.

Pro bono representation assists Intertribal Court of Southern California parties seeking domestic violence restraining orders, conservatorships, and guardianships – along with myriad other forms of relief.

Attorneys who opt to have their contact information and practice area(s) shared with parties in need of pro bono services are entitled to a reduction in Southern California Tribal Bar Association application and membership fees.

If you check the relevant box, your contact information and practice area(s) will be shared with parties in need of pro bono services by publication on the Intertribal Court of Southern California's website.
